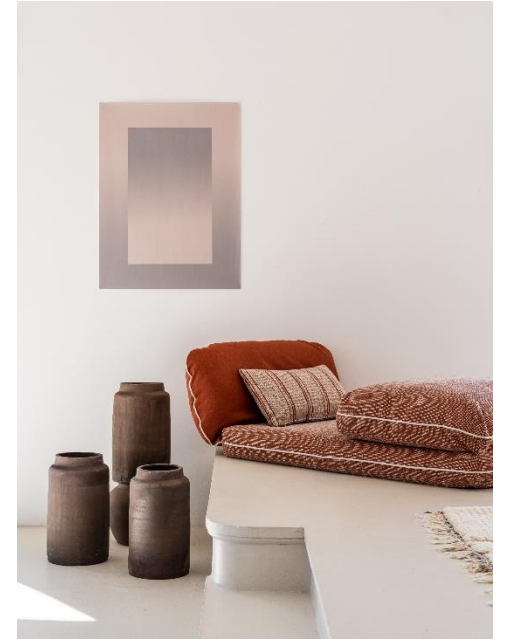

LOW WATER CONSUMPTION

In the solution-dyeing process, colour pigments are added to the core of the fibre, to guarantee colourfastness and save water. Throughout our manufacturing process, we take steps to reduce the amount of water we use, notably by recycling washing water through the installation of water treatment plants.



PFAS FREE

Dickson-Constant has invested significant resources to find alternatives to PFAS (perfluoroalkylate) chemicals and has developed an optimal non-PFAS finish for all Sunbrella upholstery fabrics. Our fabrics will retain their water repellency, durability, bright colours, appearance, softness, texture, ease of cleaning and strength.



ZERO LANDFILL

For over 30 years, Sunbrella has recycled its industrial waste such as yarn and packaging. Today, every Sunbrella manufacturing facility around the globe sends absolutely no waste to the landfill.



LESS WASTE

Our quality Sunbrella fabrics do not rot or fade and are highly resistant over time. As our fabrics do not need to be replaced as often as traditional fabrics, they generate less waste.

Endless Stories is our first collection of upholstery fabrics made from recycled fibres, designed and produced in France.



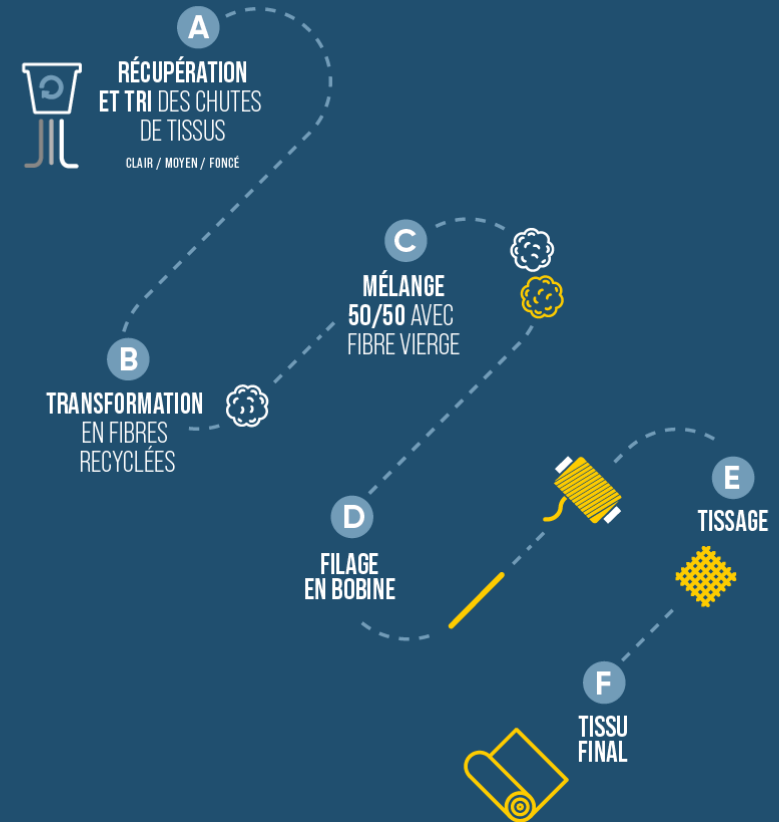
A controlled, local recycling process

On all our production lines, we recover, sort and select, by colour, waster from the production process: whether yarns, selvages or fabrics scraps.

This precious, recycled material is reintegrated into our future productions. This is how the never-ending stories of our fabrics begin. The partners in this virtuous circle are all from the Hauts-de-France region.

The recycled nature of the fabrics in the Endless Stories collection allows for slight variations in colour between batches. Flamed threads may occasionally appear, reinforcing the character of our recycled fabrics.
